



**Summer Program Assistant Position:** Would you like to earn \$10.00 an hour this summer? The Corolla Wild Horse Fund is looking for reliable, friendly summer programs staff from mid-May through early September. Children’s activities include “Paint a Mustang” and “Ride a Mustang” and “Meet a Mustang.” Locations are in Corolla (Tu-Th-Fr) and Duck (Wed). Shifts are about four hours, and the schedule offers some flexibility.

**Responsibilities, Skills, Requirements:** The *Programs Assistant* position is a part time position. Responsibilities include set up and take-down of activity tables and supplies. You will be working with kids, so you need energy, patience, and enthusiasm. Programs are outside and require some physical effort in hot summer heat. You will be representing the Corolla Wild Horse Fund and our non-profit mission to protect the wild Colonial Spanish Mustangs, so you must be outgoing and well-spoken. You must learn general information about the wild horses and the Corolla Wild Horse Fund so that you can answer general questions from the public. Experience with horses not required, but a plus. Background check required.
