RULES:

1. Contest is open to amateur photographers only.
2. This completed, signed entry form must accompany your submission. Each participant/contestant may submit **up to three (3)** photos, either current or historical, of wild horses in the herd north of Corolla, NC.
3. Photos must be submitted on a CD or thumb drive in JPG or TIFF format. The CD or thumb drive must be labeled with the photographer's name. Photos must not have any text added (e.g. a title or photographer's name). Low resolution images that lose quality when enlarged to calendar size will be rejected.
TIP: A good quality image file will usually be over 2 MB's (megabytes). If your image file size is something like 376KB (kilobytes) or 632KB, its resolution is probably too low for our calendar. 376KB is only .376MB. (1MB equals 1000KB.)
4. Photographers may resubmit photos from previous years, provided the photos were not prior winners. Follow all the same rules and procedures.
5. Photos will be registered with a random code as they are received and judges will have no information regarding the photographer.

6. **Submissions must be postmarked between July 15, 2015 and September 30, 2015.** No photos will be accepted before or after those dates. Submission address is below.
7. CWHF is pleased to announce that judges for the contest will be: Brooke Mayo (Brook Mayo Photography, NC); Walter Gresham III (Outer Banks Beach Portraits and Photography, Kill Devil Hills, NC); and Robin Caspari (Running Mare Studio, Manakin-Sabot, VA). These judges will view randomized and anonymous submissions and select their favorite images.
8. From the finalist pool of images, the 13 final calendar images will be chosen.
9. The winning photographers will be notified by December 31, 2015 and the finalist photos will be displayed on the Corolla Wild Horse Fund website and perhaps also on Facebook. Winning photos will appear in the 2017 Calendar.
10. **No photographs that violate any portion of the Currituck County Wild Horse Ordinance will be accepted** (Chapter 3; Sections 3-26 through 3-38). **Additionally, any alleged violations will be investigated and reported to the Currituck County Sheriff's Office.** Respect the wild horses: Stay at least 50 feet away from them, and do not feed or entice them.
