AMADEO—Amadeo had been blind in one eye and lost sight in his other eye during a fight with a rival stallion. Disoriented, he charged into the sea where he nearly died. Through the efforts of the CWHF, Ocean Rescue and EMT, he was moved to shore and taken to our rehab facility. Following veterinary care, Amadeo not only survived but is thriving under CWHF's care and is part of our educational program.



MOXIE—Moxie is the oldest horse at the rescue farm. She was born in the wild in Corolla and moved to Dews Island when she was a couple years old. Moxie's mother was a mare who was appropriately named Chaos, and for most of her life Moxie was known as Utter Chaos. Moxie will live out her days on the rescue farm. She is the matriarch and we respect her wishes and whims.



RITA—Rita is a 10-year-old mare who was rescued from the beach as a foal due to contracted tendons. She was adopted by a wonderful family who she lived with for many years. Rita's adopted mom became terminally ill in the spring of 2018 and she was returned to us with the promise of good care and love. We are happy to provide Rita with a forever home.

DUCKY—Ducky is a 7-year-old stallion who came to live at the rescue farm in May 2018 with his harem of 4 mares and his yearling son. Since Jan 2018, he and his harem continued to make their way around the northern fence in to False Cape and Back Bay until we were forced to have them removed. While no longer wild, they are now safe and in the Fund's care. Ducky is particularly sweet and personable.



LUNA—Born on Dews Island, Luna is about 12 years old and came to the CWHF rescue farm with her mother Brownie and six of her sisters in the fall of 2017. Luna's father was the well known Little Red Man. Luna is becoming a wonderful ambassador for her breed and has shown the gentle nature and willingness to learn that was exhibited by her mother.
