— Help Them Thrive —

- Tightly tie garbage bags before putting them in outside cans.
- If during your stay the garbage begins to overflow, contact your rental company.
- Securely fasten trash can lids. If there aren't lids for each can, contact your rental company.
- Do not leave scraps out in the yard thinking the horses or other wildlife will appreciate the "treat." Watermelon, corn cobs, apples, bread, etc. will kill.
